



# TBIT AIRLINE CREW SHUTTLE STOP RELOCATION

## Terminal B APM Pedestrian Bridge Construction

Effective Saturday, September 10, 2022 at 7AM

Duration: Approximately 5 Weeks

### ACTIVITY

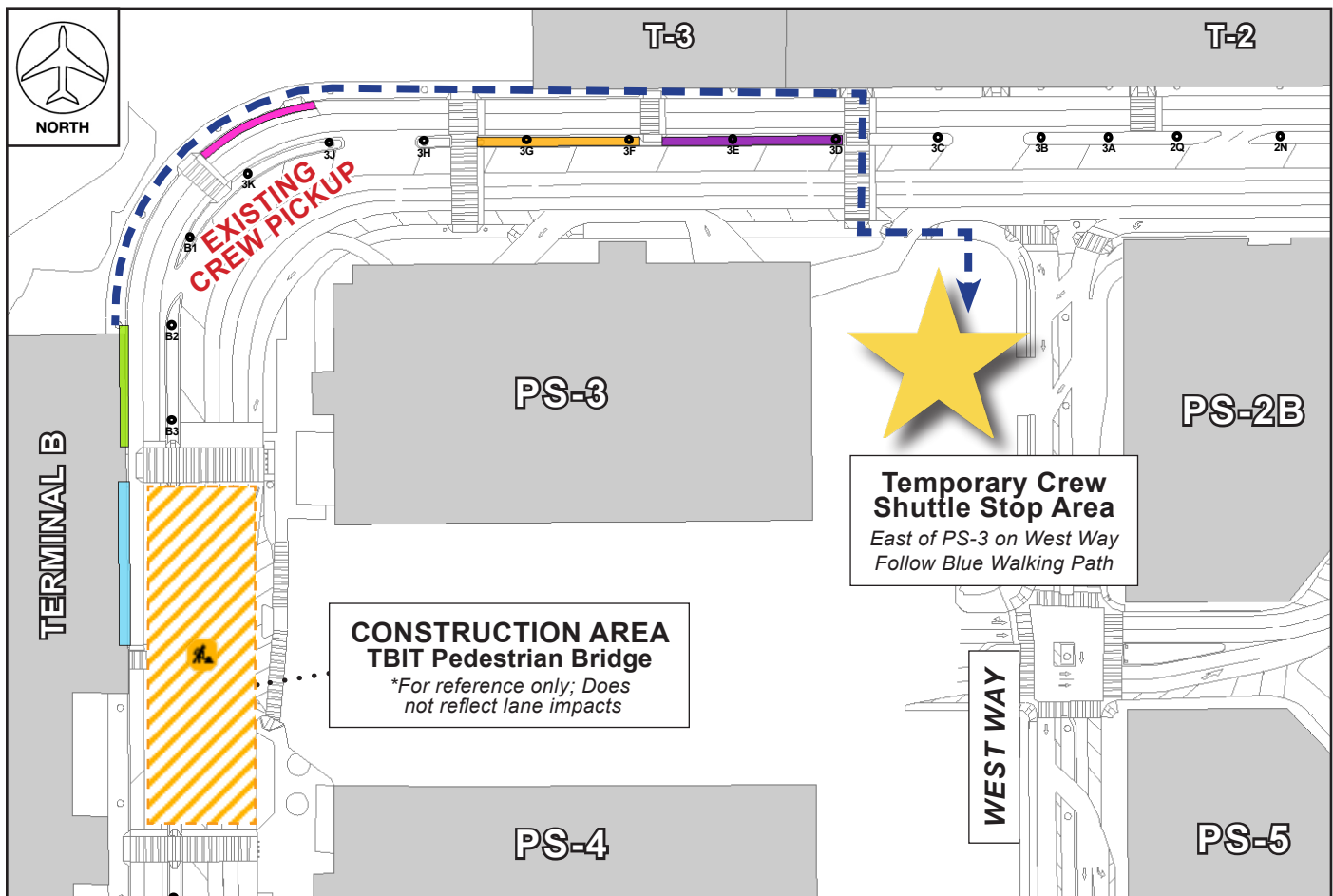
To facilitate construction of the Automated People Mover's Pedestrian Bridge between Terminal B and the West CTA Station, the Airline Crew Shuttle Stop will be temporarily relocated from the north side of Terminal B to nearby West Way, as illustrated below.

West Way is located east of Parking Structure 3. Please use the designated path of sidewalks and crosswalks to reach the temporary crew shuttle stop area. Wayfinding signage will be in place, along with flaggers to direct crew members.

The relocation will take effect Saturday, September 10 at 7AM and remain in place for approximately five weeks. After completion of the bridge, the crew shuttle stop will be restored to its original location.

The temporary crew area will feature tents and seating, as well as Crew Coordinators who will continue to help connect crews with their shuttles. Crews should continue to check-in at the podium inside TBIT upon their arrival.
