

NIGHTLY LANE RESTRICTIONS

SEPULVEDA TUNNEL FIRE DETECTION UPGRADE

Monday, February 6 through Sunday, February 26 | Nightly from 11PM to 5AM

ACTIVITY

To facilitate the City of Los Angeles Bureau of Street Services' Fire Detection Upgrade Project, the Sepulveda Tunnel will experience lane restrictions beginning Monday, February 6 through Sunday, February 26, nightly from 11PM to 5AM.

Work will close either the inner two lanes or outer two lanes on each side of the tunnel overnight. One lane of through traffic in both directions will be maintained at all times. Plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near work areas.

PHASE 1 (OUTSIDE LANES): MONDAY FEB. 6 - MONDAY FEB. 13

Southbound #2 and #3 Lanes Closed (Including Upper CTA Transition Ramp to SB Sepulveda Boulevard)
Northbound #2 and #3 Lanes Closed

PHASE 2 (INSIDE LANES): MONDAY, FEB. 13 - MONDAY, FEB. 20

Southbound #1 and #2 Lanes Closed
Northbound #1 and #2 Lanes Closed

*February 20 - 26: Contingency for final inspection and weather delays
